Item #1, 2, 3 and 5: Welcome – Meeting began promptly at 6:30pm by Betty Wong Oyama, NEA, Dept. of Neighborhood Empowerment. Pledge of Allegiance was recited, Roll Call of the Outgoing board was taken by Betty Wong. Councilwoman Nury Martinez, and Councilman Paul Krekorian were detained in traffic, so Betty Wong asked for any Announcements from Elected Official reps and moved item. (Item #12: was moved to this portion of the meeting while awaiting Council people) Comments by Elected Officials/Representatives, DONE, City Departments) Brief announcements and expressions of gratitude were given to the outgoing board by the following: Vickere Murphey from Senator Portantino's office, Caroline Menjivar from CD6 Nury Martinez' office, Jude Hernandez from Assembly 39 Luz Rivas office, and Jackie Keene from CD2 Paul Krekorian office. Betty opened the floor to Public Comment: A young lady spoke on diet concerns regarding Sun Valley. A representative from Food and Water Watch spoke about concerns regarding a recent LADWP proposal regarding Clean Power and will be contacting the executive board to make a presentation at a future meeting. The Outgoing

board was excused. The incoming board was seated, and the board Orientation began with Betty Wong, DONE Representative until Nury Martinez arrived. (Which was approx. 7pm) Nury asked the newly seated board to stand, The Code of Conduct was administered, and the new board took their seats. Special Recognition was given by Council woman Nury Martinez to 15-year-old Vincent Gamboa. Gamboa, a Student of Sun Valley's North Valley Military Institute who on April 22, 2019 used the First Aid and Lifesaving Training he learned at school and was able to assist a gunshot victim in front of the school.

Councilman Krekorian arrived shortly after the Councilwoman, and certificates of appreciation were given to the outgoing board members that had stayed behind. Group Photographs were taken of the outgoing board with the council members, as well as the newly seated board.

Both Council Members took time to recognize and Thank the Outgoing Board for their service, as well as give appreciation to the new incoming board, acknowledging that although this is an elected position, we are all volunteers and they appreciate our hard work. Nury acknowledged we were one of her favorite NC's always giving extra of ourselves to improve our community.

Item #4: Nominations and Election of Executive Officers was started by Betty Wong. She took nominations for:

- 2) Secretary: Serj Danielian was nominated and voted in as Secretary. Vote Count 11 Yes, O No, 3 Ineligible. After the meeting was over Serj Danielian explained his time constraints with DONE Betty Wong and President O'Gara, he was thanked for his service)
- 3) 1st Vice President. Rick Power was nominated and voted in as 1st Vice President. **Vote Count 11 Yes, 0 No, 3 Ineligible.**
- 4) 2nd Vice President. Martha Fiero was nominated and voted in as 2nd Vice President. **Vote Count 11 Yes, 0 No, 3 Ineligible.**
- 5) Treasurer. Cindy Sower was nominated and voted in as Treasurer. **Vote Count 11 Yes, 0 No, 3 Ineligible.**
- 6) 2nd Signatory. Eddie Venegas was nominated and voted in as 2nd Signatory. **Vote Count 11 Yes, 0 No, 3 Ineligible.**
- 7) Bank Card Holder. Mike O'Gara was nominated and voted in as Bank Card Holder. **Vote Count 11 Yes, 0 No, 3 Ineligible.**

Item #7 and 9: Motion/Discussion/Vote to approve the Neighborhood Council Bankcard Missing

Receipt Affidavit from Domino's Pizza \$102.82 dated 3/22/2019 that was never received by SVANC or SVANC Bankcard holder as well as the March 2019 MER which were being held up with the City Clerk because of the lost receipt. Item #11: Motion/Discussion/Vote to hire and pay Susan Lustig with Barkley Communications LLC, up to \$350.00 a month to update SVANC 's website for May and June, & not to exceed \$700.00 for services to post Meeting Agendas, Minutes and Currents Events. Also to monitor, add or delete SVANC Board Members' email addresses on the server. In addition, to Maintain, Update, and Email SVANC Constant Contact newsletters to SVANC Mailing List for all SVANC Meetings and Events. Susan has agreed if the work exceeds the budget allotment for that month, she will complete the tasks at no additional cost or billing to SVANC.
